| 23. | <p>Please use this text box to provide any comments regarding the data submitted in this report (optional, no limit).</p> <p>The College has begun a course clean-up process that aims to deactivate courses that have not been offered within the curriculum review cycle (currently 5 years). This is decreasing the number of courses gradually over time to more accurately reflect the curriculum offered at the College. In addition, the successful course completion rate was updated for the current year (fall 2017) and previous year (fall 2016) due to recently resolved issues with reporting that affected the fall 2016 term data. Furthermore, transfer figures now reflect a methodology that matches the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office transfer reporting; thus the numbers are much smaller than in previous years, and the Institution-Set Standard for this indicator was recently adjusted to reflect this. The College reviews its performance data annually in light of standards and targets. Standards were updated for several indicators in spring 2017. For the employment rate data (#19), only the programs with at least 10 or more graduates in any of the three years covered in</p> |

the report are included. For each program, the years with fewer than 10 graduates defaulted to values of 0 for that year's employment rate.
