




Jobs (2020)

Job posting activity is high in San Diego-Chula Vista-Carlsbad, CA. The national average for an area this size is 231* job postings/mo, while there are 262 here.

















Retirement Risk Is About Average, While Overall Diversity Is High




Retiring Soon

Racial Diversity



Occupation Age Breakdown




Occupation Race/Ethnicity Breakdown
