

Jobs (2018)

Compensation

Job posting activity is low in San Diego-Chula Vista-Carlsbad, CA. The national average for an area this size is 13* job postings/mo, while there are 7 here.

















Retirement Risk Is About Average, While Overall Diversity Is High




Retiring Soon

Racial diversity is high in San Diego-Chula Vista-Carlsbad, CA. The national average for an area this size is 229* racially diverse employees, while there are 443 here.




Gender Diversity


Occupation Age Breakdown




Occupation Race/Ethnicity Breakdown
