Cuyamaca College's Behavioral & Social Sciences Embedded Counseling: Access to Services and Persistence in 2023-2024

Report Prepared July 2024

Cuyamaca College's Behavioral and Social Sciences (BSS) Embedded Counselor met with 88 students in the 2023-2024 academic year between July 1st, 2023 and June 30th, 2024.

Student Access to BSS Embedded Counseling Services in 2023-2024 by Race and Ethnicity

Compared to all students in 2023-2024, the BSS Embedded Counselor met with an overrepresentation of Middle Eastern students (25% compared to 21% college-wide) and Latinx students (45% compared to 35% college-wide), and an underrepresentation of African-American or Black students (3% compared to 5% college-wide). No Asian students or Pacific Islander students met with the BSS Embedded Counselor.

Compared to all BSS majors in 2023-2024, the BSS Embedded Counselor met with an overrepresentation of Middle Eastern students (25% compared to 23% of BSS majors), and an underrepresentation of African-American or Black students (3% compared to 5% of BSS majors).

Student Access to BSS Embedded Counseling Services in 2023-2024 by Age

Compared to all students in 2023-2024, the BSS Embedded Counselor met with an overrepresentation of students age 30-49 years old (30% compared to 22% college-wide), and an underrepresentation of students age 50+ years old (1% compared to 7% college-wide).

Compared to BSS majors in 2023-2024, the BSS Embedded Counselor served an underrepresentation of students age 25+ years old (41% compared to 53% of BSS majors).

Student Access to BSS Embedded Counseling Services in 2023-2024 by Economically Disadvantaged Status

The BSS Embedded Counselor served economically disadvantaged students well: 76% of students who met with the BSS Embedded Counselor were economically disadvantaged, compared to 52% of all students college-wide, and compared to 62% of BSS majors.

Student Fall-to-Spring Persistence in 2023-2024

Students who met with the BSS Embedded Counselor in 2023-2024 were more likely to persist from Fall 2023 to Spring 2024 at Cuyamaca College (88%), compared to all students (58%) and compared to all BSS majors (61%).

African-American or Black students who met with the BSS Embedded Counselor experienced a relatively low persistence rate (50%); however, this persistence rate was higher compared to all African-American or Black students (45%) and compared to all African-American or Black BSS majors (28%).

Latinx students who met with the BSS Embedded Counselor experienced a relatively high persistence rate (86%) compared to all Latinx students (53%) and compared to all Latinx BSS majors (58%).

While Middle Eastern students experienced the highest fall-to-spring persistence rate of any group college-wide (76%) and among BSS majors (80%), the 17 Middle Eastern students who met with the BSS Embedded Counselor experienced a 100% persistence rate.

White students who met with the BSS Embedded Counselor persisted at a higher rate (75%) compared to all White students (53%) and compared to all White BSS majors (55%).
