#### **Definitions**

#### **Course Success Rate**

Course success rates reflect the percentage of enrollments in credit courses that were successful (i.e., grades A, B, C and P) in the given term, out of enrollments in credit courses that resulted in grades A, B, C, D, F, P, NP, I, or W in the given term.

#### Remedial English Progress Rate (Scorecard)

Remedial English progress rates reflect the percentage of students who first enrolled in a course below transfer level in English during the cohort year and completed a transfer-level English course within six years.

### Remedial ESL Progress Rate (Scorecard)

Remedial ESL progress rates reflect the percentage of students who first enrolled in a course below transfer level in ESL during the cohort year and completed a transfer-level English course within six years.

#### **Remedial Math Progress Rate (Scorecard)**

Remedial math progress rates reflect the percentage of students who first enrolled in a course below college level in math during the cohort year and completed a college-level math course within six years.

#### **Certificate Completion Rate (Scorecard)**

Certificate completion rates reflect the percentage of students who attempted any level of math or English and completed six or more units in their first three semesters, who completed a certificate within six years.

#### **Degree Completion Rate (Scorecard)**

Degree completion rates reflect the percentage of students who attempted any level of math or English class and completed six or more units in their first three semesters, who completed a degree within six years.

#### **Transfer Rate (Scorecard)**

Transfer rates reflect the percentage of students who attempted any level of math or English class and completed six or more units in their first three semesters, who transferred within six years.
