

CLASSIFIED NON-RESIDENT APPLICATION CHECKLIST

You have been classified as an out-of-state resident because of information you supplied on your Cuyamaca or Grossmont College admission application. A resident is a student who has been physically present in the state for at least 1 year and 1 day prior to the start of the term they plan to enroll; and intend to make California their permanent place of residence. Once a student has been classified as an out-of-state resident, they must provide proper documentation before they can be reclassified as a California resident for the purpose of paying California enrollment fees. If you cannot provide the proper documentation, you will remain classified as an out-of-state resident until you can do so. You may still enroll as a non-resident. Non-resident tuition is currently \$356 per unit in addition to the \$46.00 per unit enrollment fee. Please note, the non-resident fee will increase to \$363/unit beginning Fall 2025. All fees are subject to change.

*One document cannot satisfy both categories simultaneously.

1. INTENT – submit at least one document from the following options

2. PHYSICAL PRESENCE – submit at least one document from the following options

Ownership of a Business in California Utility bills Showing a California Physical Address Verification of California Public Assistance (Cash Bank / Credit Card Statements Showing a California Physical Address Aid, Medical, SSI, Cal Fresh, Etc)

3. FINANCIAL INDEPENDENCE (not required for students 24 years of age and up)

California law requires that the financial independence of a nonresident student seeking reclassification as a resident be included in the factors to be considered in the determination of residence. You must not have received any form of financial support from a parent residing outside of California for the year prior to your claim of resident status. Your parents may be required to submit appropriate tax forms to verify. Additional documentation may be required.

If your current status is unmarried and under the age of 19

Your residency is determined by your parents'/legal guardian Residency. Documentation of Physical Presence and Intent is required (see samples above.) *If parent/legal guardian is not applicable, additional options/exemptions may apply.

Non US citizens: indicate the type of visa or immigration card INS has issued you

Permanent Resident:	Please provide immigration documentation within one year, unless the date is otherwise exempted.
□ Visa:	Please provide immigration documentation within one year, unless the date is otherwise exempted.
