Based on the Student Conduct data, there was an over-representation of male students (45% compared to 43% college-wide). In addition, there was an over-representation of Middle Eastern students (49% compared to 18% college-wide) and White students (29% compared to 28% college-wide).

The information will be helpful for the development of the academic integrity seminar. In addition, the results will be utilized for the student conduct process change recommendations which are currently being developed by the Academic Integrity team.
