





Classroom presentations on resources.



More hours to support evening and weekend students



How likely are you to collaborate with a librarian to provide an instruction session for your classes?



If somewhat or extremely unlikely, would you prefer to have a personalized research guide to support students' research skills in your classes?




How useful would it be to have a Canvas container to refer your students to take to develop their research skills, or import a Canvas container to use in place of an instruction session with a librarian?

What is the best way to share information about library resources and services with you?








What is your area of study?




On average, how often did you use any library service in the last year (2021-2022 academic year)?



Which services did you use in the last year? Please select all that apply.









How satisfied are you with the library's current printed book selection?




