This 2022 edition of the Bi-National Transborder Conference will be held from Monday, November 28th to Friday, December 2nd 2022 in multiple venues: San Diego City College, Mesa College, Miracosta College, University of San Diego, San Diego State University, Universidad Autónoma de Baja California and El Colegio de la Frontera in Tijuana, and Cuyamaca College who will host the closing event with two panel discussions, an art exhibit, and reception on Thursday, December 1st from 5 to 9 PM.
